

It is composed of high, rugged, plateau-like mountain spurs, between which are the heads of streams flowing to Buffalo River. The altitude ranges from 8,000 to 11,000 feet. There is very little timber, and that is on the lower slopes of the valleys of the streams, the summits of the ridges and plateau being bare. T. 46 2T., R. 111 W.--The eastern part of this township is made up of spurs from the Snake-Wind River divide, between which flow, in high valleys, branches of Buffalo River. The western portion is comparatively low, undulating country, in which is the valley of the Xorth Fork of Buffalo River. The altitude ranges from 7,500 feet up to 10,000. The timber is scattering. The undulating country of the western portion is covered by groves alternating with parks. Upon the lower slopes of the high mountain ridges there is scattering timber. The ridge rising in the southeastern portion of the township is well covered with forests. T. 46 N., R. 112 W.--The...
