Brand New Book ***** Print on Demand *****.On March 28, we issued report on FHWA s oversight of value engineering in the Federal-aid highway program and its effectiveness. The audit objectives were to determine whether FHWA s oversight is adequate to ensure that: (1) value engineering studies are performed on all Federal-aid projects that have an estimated cost of \$25 million or more; (2) value engineering studies are performed on all Federal-aid projects that have a high potential for cost savings; and (3) all value engineering recommendations that can be implemented are approved, permitting the greatest degree of potential savings to be achieved. Value engineering provides a substantial opportunity for states to obtain the most value from Federal-aid funds by achieving savings on planned construction projects. Furthermore, it has the potential to serve as a key tool in FHWA s stewardship of Federal funds. Historically, states have saved an average of 5 percent of estimated project costs by performing value engineering studies and accepting recommendations. From FY 2001 through FY 2004, states collectively reported \$4.2 billion in recommended savings (about \$1 billion annually). During the...
